

ANDREW ELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Andrew Ell Memorial Scholarship awards one \$500 academic scholarship annually to individuals pursuing an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Electric Power Generation Technology (EPG) from State Technical College of Missouri. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based on availability of funds.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicants enrolling in the EPG program will receive priority consideration.
- B. Applicant should be a citizen of the United States.
- C. Applicant should have a GPA of at least 2.5 upon graduation from a prerequisite program at State Technical College of Missouri.

SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. To be considered, applicants must forward a complete application packet by the scholarship application deadline of **February 15**. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based equally upon the following:
 - Financial need.
 - Academic achievement.
 - Civic involvement through school and community.
 - Leadership demonstrated through extracurricular involvement.
- B. Selection Priority. This is a one time, annual scholarship awarded to a full-time student attending State Technical College of Missouri. In the event a student is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment in the year the scholarship is awarded, the scholarship will be transferred to the next available alternate.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$500 that is paid directly to the recipient's account at State Technical College of Missouri in the semester upon the student's verified enrollment in the EPG program. The scholarship will apply toward the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools and/or any other costs associated with a student's education.
- D. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based on availability of funds.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the upcoming academic year is **March 15**. Please submit the following to be considered:

- State Technical College of Missouri Admissions Application for the EPG program.
- Complete the online Scholarship Application (including personal goal statement and two character references) at www.statetechmo.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php.

EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis in the EPG program, attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing.
- B. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the EPG program, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available selection.
- C. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet and to contact character references to State Technical College of Missouri, the Foundation for State Technical College of Missouri and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s).
- D. If selected, the recipient agrees to send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at State Technical College of Missouri no later than one month after award is announced.
