

CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT DISTRIBUTORS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE OF MISSOURI SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Construction Equipment Distributors Association, St. Louis, Missouri, awards two \$1,000 scholarships each year to students pursuing an associate of Applied Science Degree in one of the following State Technical College of Missouri programs: Heavy Equipment Technology, Heavy Equipment Technology-CAT Dealer Service Technician Option, or Electric Power Generation Technology. Scholarship awards are to fund availability.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be enrolled as a full-time (12 hours minimum per semester), first year or second year student.
- B. Applicant should be a student in good academic standing with a minimum 2.5 college or high school cumulative GPA.
- C. Applicant must be a citizen of the United States.

SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. To be considered, applicants must forward a complete application packet by the scholarship application deadline. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based equally upon the following:
 - Academic achievement.
 - Personal goals and/or interests in the heavy equipment/truck industry.
 - Civic involvement through school and community.
 - Leadership skills demonstrated through extracurricular and academic involvement.
 - Organization involvement.
 - Financial need.
- B. Selection Priority. Selection will be based upon the applicant's demonstrated academic abilities and achievement, career goals articulated through the applicant's personal goal statement, extracurricular activities, student vocational organization involvement, and mechanical aptitude.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$1,000 during the award year. The scholarship award will be credited to the recipient's account at State Technical College of Missouri. The scholarship will apply toward the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other costs associated with a student's education.

APPLICATION PACKET

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the upcoming academic year is **March 15**. Please submit the following to be considered:

- State Technical College of Missouri Admissions Application.
- High school transcript or official GED score report.
- College Transcripts if applicable.
- ACT scores to State Technical College of Missouri (State Tech ACT Code: 5105), or take the COMPASS Test on the State Tech campus.
- Complete the online Scholarship Application at www.statetechmo.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php. The personal goal statement should include: personal history, life experiences, motivation, and career goals.

EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- B. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirements of the scholarship, the funds will be awarded to the next available alternate.
- C. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet and to contact character references to State Technical College of Missouri, the Foundation for State Technical College of Missouri and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s).
- D. If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor scholarship winners and the recipient must send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at State Technical College of Missouri no later than one month after award is announced.
