

ELECTRICITY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP-STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE OF MISSOURI SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Sponsored by the State Technical College of Missouri Electricity Club, one \$300 scholarship is awarded annually to a first-year student pursuing an Associate of Applied Science Degree at State Technical College of Missouri in Industrial Electricity. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based on availability of funds.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be enrolled as a first-year full-time student (12 hours minimum per semester) in Industrial Electricity.
- B. Applicant should enroll the fall semester immediately following graduation from high school if entering as a first-time freshman.
- C. Applicant should be a citizen of the United States.
- D. Applicant should have a high school GPA of at least 2.5 upon graduation, or GED with 260 minimum score.

SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. To be considered, applicants must forward a complete application packet by the scholarship application deadline. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based equally upon the following:
 - Civic involvement through school and community.
 - Leadership demonstrated through extracurricular involvement.
 - Ability to communicate clearly defined personal goals through written essay.
 - Preference will be given to those demonstrating financial need.
- B. Selection Priority. This is a one time, annual scholarship awarded to a full-time student attending State Technical College of Missouri. In the event a student is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester in the year the scholarship is awarded, the scholarship will be transferred to the next available alternate.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$300 that is paid directly to the recipient's account at State Technical College of Missouri in the fall semester upon the student's verified enrollment. The scholarship will apply toward the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools and/or any other costs associated with a student's education.
- D. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based on availability of funds.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the upcoming academic year is **March 15**. Please submit the following to be considered:

- State Technical College of Missouri Admissions Application.
- High school transcript or official GED score report.
- College Transcripts if applicable.

- ACT scores to State Technical College of Missouri (State Tech ACT Code: 5105), or take the COMPASS Test at the State Tech main campus.
- Complete the online Scholarship Application (including personal goal statement and two character references) at www.statetechmo.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php.

EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing. The student is expected to join the electricity club and be an active member.
- B. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available selection.
- C. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet and to contact character references to State Technical College of Missouri, the Foundation for State Technical College of Missouri and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s). If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor annual scholarship winners.
- D. If selected, the recipient agrees to send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at State Technical College of Missouri no later than one month after award is announced.
