

- How do I schedule the ACCUPLACER test?

- How is the test proctored?
 1. ACCUPLACER is a computer-based test.
- How much does it cost?
 1. The testing fee is \$20 per testing session.
- Can I take it more than once?
 1. Yes, you can reschedule and take your test before the start of the semester.
- How to study for the ACCUPLACER test?

ACCUPLACER Testing Preparation Sites:

1. The ACCUPLACER web-based study app features practice tests in each test subject. It is accessible from most devices with internet access, and will help you become familiar with the content and format of the ACCUPLACER test questions.
 - “Learn as you go” tests provide you with explanation of the correct or incorrect responses.
 - Sample tests are similar to the real thing, so you’ll know ahead of time what your experience will be like on test day.
 - You can save your work at any time, and come back when it’s convenient for you.
 - You can review your score history to see what you’re already doing well and what skills you should focus on improving.

- What sections do I need to study?
 1. State Tech uses three sections of the ACCUPLACER test: Writing, Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra, and Statistics, and Reading.
 - What is the time limit?
 1. The test is an untimed test.
 - Why do I need to take this test?
 1. State Tech uses ACT and ACCUPLACER test for program admittance and course placement.
 - Do I have to take all three sections?
 1. You do not need to take all three sections. If we have additional test scores, Admissions staff can help determine what section(s) you will need to take.
 - Do I have to take all the sections at the same time?
 1. You can schedule the sections as they fit your comfort. If you want to space out the sections, we will accommodate your needs.
 - How many questions are there?
 1. Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra, and Statistics – 20 questions: Focus on a range of topics including computing with rational numbers, applying ratios and proportional reasoning, creating linear expressions and equations, graphing and applying linear equations, understanding probability and sets, and interpreting graphical displays.
 2. Reading – 20 questions: Ability to derive meaning from a range of prose texts and to determine the meaning of words and phrases in short and extended contexts.
 3. Writing – 25 questions: Ability to revise and edit a range of prose texts for effective expression of ideas and for conformity to the conventions of Standard Written English sentence structure, usage, and punctuation.
 - When are my results available?
 1. After testing your results will be immediate. Admission staff will meet with you to discuss your scores based on your interested program of study.
