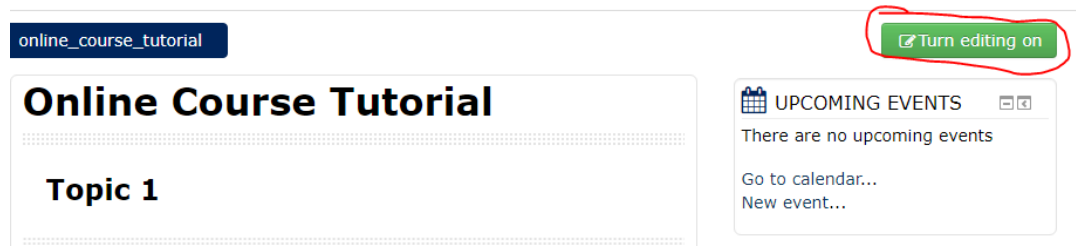


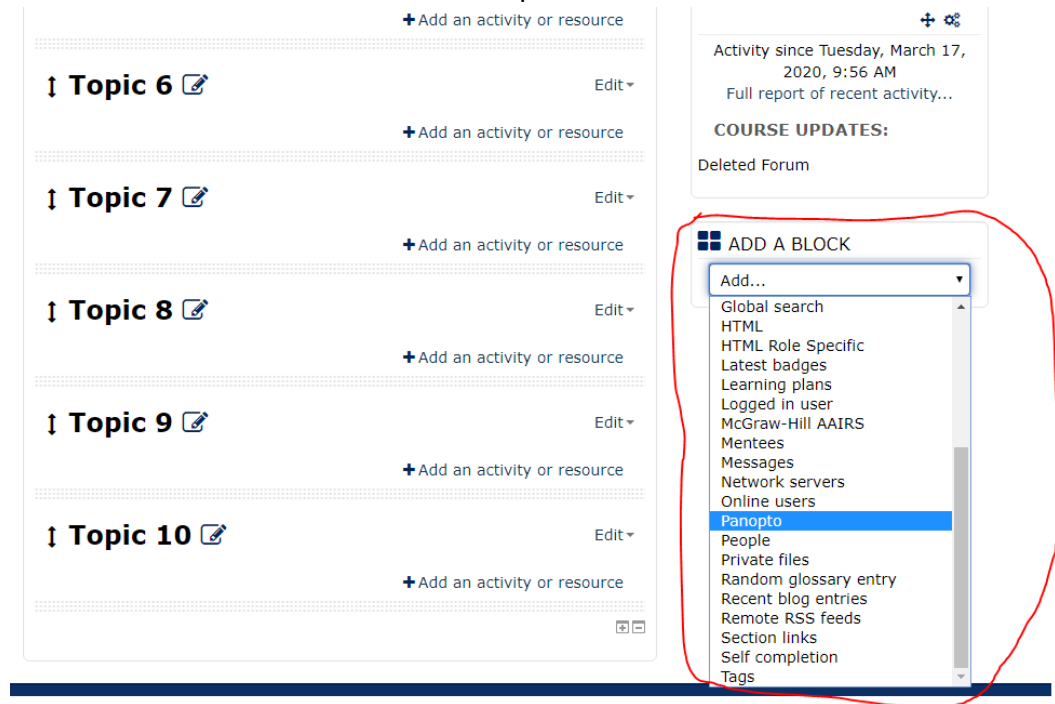
Configuring and Installing Panopto for your Moodle Course

Please follow the steps below to add the Panopto Block to your Moodle course and configure it for use. If you only need to install the Panopto Recorder software, please skip to step 5.

1. Turn editing on:



2. Find the "Add a Block" control and select Panopto:



- Click the Provision Course link to create a Panopto folder for your course and link your new block to it:

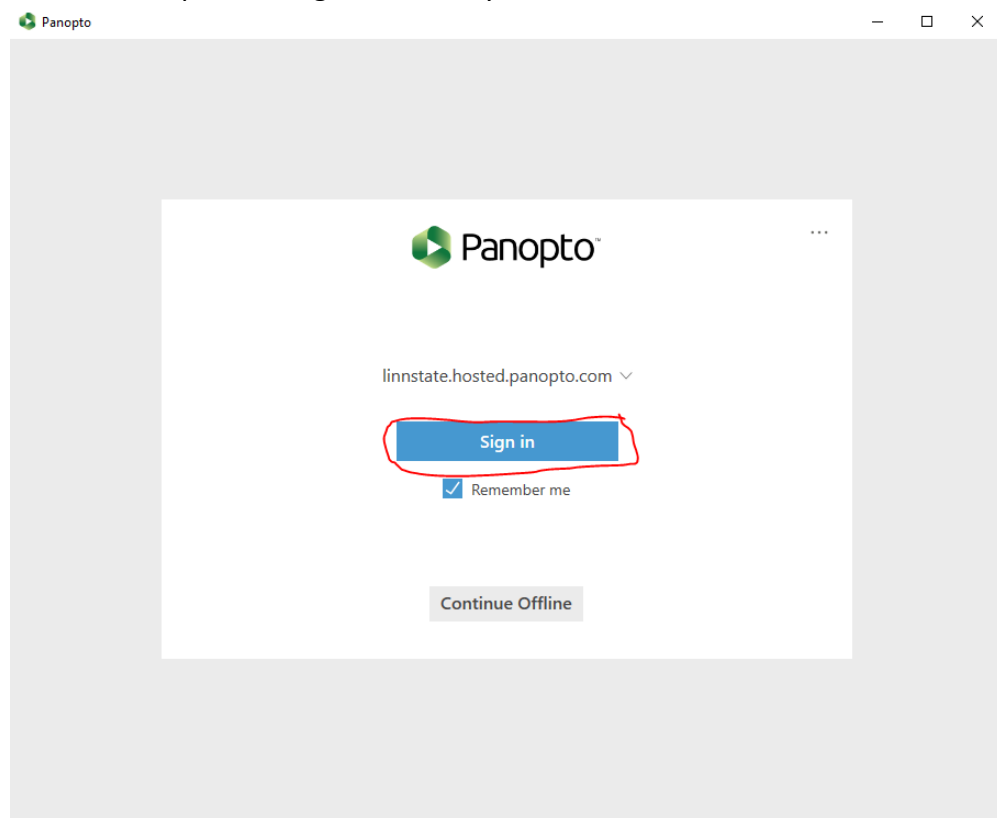
- Once your course finishes provisioning, you will see a screen like the image below. Click the “Back to course” link to return to your course:

- Click the Download Recorder link for your operating system in the Panopto Block in your course:

6. Run the installer when it finishes downloading and follow the installation instructions. Please use the default installation options. The recorder software is already configured to work with our Panopto site.

7. After the Panopto Recorder finishes installing, it will prompt you to sign in. Click the blue “Sign in” button to open the login screen in your web browser:



8. Leave the login method set to Moodle and click the green Sign in button:
