High School Transcript or HiSET/GED Scores

Education records – Submit all official transcripts including college transcripts for dual credit courses taken in high school.

Test scores – Submit all ACT and/or Accuplacer test scores:

- Test scores are used for program admittance and course placement
- Test results must be less than five years old
- Test scores may be waived with approved transfer credit

ACT Test Scores

- Math 15
- Reading 18
- English 18

Accuplacer Test Scores

- Math 34
- Reading 81
- English 81

OR Accuplacer Next Gen Test Scores

- Math 230
- Reading 250
- English 251

A minimum of four hours of documented Observation Experience in a general dental office to include a written summary describing the experience. This requirement is waived with prior employment in a dental office.
