High School Transcript or HiSET/GED Scores

Please submit any previous college transcripts for evaluation.

Education records – Submit all official transcripts including college transcripts for dual credit courses taken in high school.

General Education prerequisites of English Composition and College Algebra with a grade of C or better are required to be considered for the program.

Test scores – Submit all ACT and/or Accuplacer test scores:

- Test scores are used for program admittance and course placement
- Test scores may be waived with approved transfer credit

Associate of Applied Science Degree requirements:

ACT

- Composite: 18
- Reading: 18

Applicants can retest using the Accuplacer – Next Generation test for reading if they did not meet the minimum required ACT sub-score.

TEAS Test Scores – A minimum composite score of 60 is required. To schedule your test, go to <http://www.statetechmo.edu/contact-admissions/testing/>.

Verification of Observation Experience at two (2) different radiology departments, one of which must be a hospital setting. A total of 12 hours of observation is required with 6 hours in each setting. An Applicant Observation Evaluation form and a Statement of Confidentiality must also be completed for each observation.
