

CAROL SCHNEIDER SCHOLARSHIP SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Practical Nursing Technology graduates, in honor of Ms. Carol Schneider sponsors one \$500 scholarship is awarded annually to a full-time student pursuing a Certificate in Practical Nursing Technology. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based upon availability of funds.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be enrolled as a full-time (12 hours minimum per semester) student in the Practical Nursing Technology program.
- B. Applicant should be in good academic standing with a minimum of 2.5 college or high school cumulative GPA. Or GED with 260 minimum score.

SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based equally upon the following:
 - Ability to communicate clearly defined personal goals through the personal goal statement (on application).
 - Academic Performance.
 - Civic involvement through school and community.
 - Leadership demonstrated through extracurricular involvement.
 - Financial need.
- B. Selection Priority. In the event a student is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the spring semester in the year the scholarship is awarded, the scholarship will be transferred to the next available alternate.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$500. The scholarship award will be credited to the recipient's account at State Technical College of Missouri. The scholarship will apply toward the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other costs associated with a student's education.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the upcoming academic year is **March 15**. Please complete the online Scholarship Application at www.statetechmo.edu/scholarship-application/.

EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing.
- B. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet and to contact character references to State Technical College of Missouri, the Foundation for State Technical College of Missouri and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s). If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor annual scholarship winners.
- C. Participate in Ceremonies. If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor scholarship winners.
- D. Thank You Letters. If selected, the recipient must send a thank you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at State Technical College of Missouri no later than one month after award is announced.
