

FOLEY EQUIPMENT SCHOLARSHIP SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Caterpillar, Foley Equipment, and State Technical College of Missouri award up to ten \$1,000 scholarships to students pursuing an associate of Applied Science Degree in one of the following State Technical College of Missouri programs: Heavy Equipment Technology, Medium/Heavy Truck Technology or the Heavy Equipment Technology-CAT Dealer Service Technician Option.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be enrolled as a full-time (12 hours minimum per semester). First year students receive priority consideration.
- B. Applicant should be enrolled in one of the following program: Heavy Equipment Technology, Medium/Heavy Truck Technology or the Heavy Equipment Technology-CAT Dealer Service Technician Option.
- C. Applicant should be a student in good academic standing with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.
- D. Applicant should reside in Foley Equipment region.

SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based equally upon the following:
 - Personal goals and/or interests in the heavy equipment/truck industry.
 - Leadership skills demonstrated through extracurricular and academic involvement.
 - Proven abilities.
 - Organization involvement.
 - Financial need.
- B. Selection Priority. The selection committee will choose up to ten students from the Foley Equipment dealer region. Alternates will be identified in the event a recipient is unable to fulfill the expectations of the scholarship.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$1,000 during the award year. The scholarship award will be credited to the recipient's account at State Technical College of Missouri. The scholarship will apply toward the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other costs associated with a student's education.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the upcoming academic year is **March 15**. Please complete the online Scholarship Application at www.statetechmo.edu/scholarship-application/.

EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing.
- B. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet and to contact character references to State Technical College of Missouri, the Foundation for State Technical College of Missouri and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s).
- C. Participate in Ceremonies. If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor scholarship winners and the recipient must send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor.
- D. Thank You Letters. If selected, the recipient must send a thank you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at State Technical College of Missouri no later than one month after award is announced.
