

INTERSTATES SCHOLARSHIP SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Interstates Foundation awards one \$1,500 scholarship to an individual pursuing an associate of Applied Science Degree in Automation & Robotics Technology or Electrical Technology at State Technical College of Missouri. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based on availability of funds.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be enrolled as a first-year or second year full-time student (12 hours minimum per semester).
- B. Applicant should be a student in good academic standing with a minimum 2.5 high school cumulative GPA, or GED with 550 minimum score.
- C. Applicant should demonstrate financial need.
- D. Applicant who represents diversity will receive priority consideration.

SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based equally upon the following:
 - Civic involvement through school and community.
 - Leadership demonstrated through extracurricular involvement.
 - Ability to communicate clearly defined personal goals through the personal goal statement (on application).
 - Financial need.
- B. Selection Priority. This is a one-time, annual scholarship awarded to a full-time student attending State Technical College of Missouri. Alternates will be identified in the event a recipient is unable to fulfill the expectations of the scholarship.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$1,500, which is applied to recipient's account at State Technical College of Missouri in the fall semester upon the student's verified enrollment. The scholarship can be used for the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other costs associated with a student's education.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the upcoming academic year is **March 15**. Please complete the online Scholarship Application at www.statetechmo.edu/scholarship-application/.

EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing.
- B. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application and to contact character references to State Technical College of Missouri, the Foundation for State Technical College of Missouri and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s).
- C. Participate in Ceremonies. If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor scholarship winners
- D. Thank You Letters. The recipient must send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at State Technical College of Missouri no later than one month after award is announced.
