

STEELVILLE MANUFACTURING SCHOLARSHIP SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Steeleville Manufacturing in Steeleville, MO, offers five \$4,000 scholarships (split over two years, \$2,000 per year) to a student pursuing an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Design and Drafting Engineering Technology or Precision Machining Technology at State Technical College of Missouri. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based on availability of funds.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be enrolled as a first year full-time student (12 hours minimum per semester) pursuing an Associates of Applied Science Degree in Design and Drafting Engineering Technology or Precision Machining Technology.
- B. Applicants should be a graduate of Bourbon High School, Cuba High School, Potosi High School, Salem High School, St. James High School, Steeleville High School or Viburnum High School.
- C. Applicant should have a high school GPA of at least 2.5 and ACT score of at least 17.

SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based equally upon the eligibility requirements along with financial need.
- B. Scholarship Award. The scholarship is awarded in two installments of \$2,000 each year (\$4,000 total) for tuition, fees, books, tools and/or any other costs associated with the recipient's education. The scholarship award will be paid directly to the recipient's account at State Technical College of Missouri. The first installment of \$2,000 will be dispersed during the fall semester in the year the scholarship is awarded. The second installment of \$2,000 will be dispersed the second year, first semester contingent upon the recipient meeting expectations of scholarship.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the upcoming academic year is **March 15**. Please complete the online Scholarship Application at www.statetechmo.edu/scholarship-application/

EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing of at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
- B. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet and to contact character references to State Technical College of Missouri, the Foundation for State Technical College of Missouri and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s).
- C. Participate in Ceremonies. If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor scholarship winners
- D. Thank You Letters. If selected, the recipient must send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation for State Technical College of Missouri no later than one month after award is announced.
